## How to get to St Thomas Centre

### On Foot

**From Piccadilly Station: (0.5 miles / 12 minutes)** take the Fairfield St exit from the station. Walk straight ahead and cross Fairfield St by the pedestrian crossing (ignoring the crossing to the right). Follow London Road under the railway bridge. Continue past the McDonald Manchester hotel following the sign for the A6 to Stockport. Cross under the flyover, past the skate park on your left, then cross over the road onto Downing Street. Continue past Speedy Services and Spirit Studios until you arrive at Ardwick Green North. Turn left past the army base and follow the road around to the right behind the park. The St Thomas Centre is the church building on the left set back from the street next to Cotter Street.

### By Bicycle

**From the A6 Northbound:** Once you are in Ardwick you will approach a roundabout with the O2 Apollo on your right hand side. At the roundabout, take the third exit onto Higher Ardwick and then the first left turn onto Ardwick Green North. St Thomas Centre is on your right hand side.

**From the A6 Southbound:** Go past Piccadilly train station, cross under the flyover, past the skate park on your left and take your third turning on the left (just before the park) onto Ardwick Green North. Follow the road around to the right and St Thomas Centre is on your left hand side.

We have cycle racks available and can loan you a cycle lock. If you require a lock please ask at reception.

### By Bus

There is a frequent bus service between London Road (the road linking Piccadilly railway station to Piccadilly Gardens) and Ardwick Green via bus nos. 192, 201, 202, 203, 205. The closest bus stop is Ardwick Green South (opposite Ardwick Green Park).

### By Train

The closest train station is Piccadilly Station (0.5 miles away). You can either catch the bus, a taxi or walk from the station.

**By Bus (approx. 5 minutes)** – take the Fairfield St exit from the station (signed ‘local buses’). As you leave the station by the taxi stand the bus stop is immediately on your right on the same side of the road. Take either bus numbers 192, 201, 202, 203, 205 and ask for Ardwick Green.

**By Taxi (approx.. 2 minutes)** – take the Fairfield St exit from the station, the taxi rank is in front of you as you exit.

**On Foot (approx. 12 minutes)** – As above

## How to get to St Thomas Centre

### By Car

Our postcode for sat nav is M12 6FZ but please note that if you enter our postcode into Google Maps you will get the wrong location. Instead please enter St Thomas Centre.

**From the A6 Northbound:** Once you are in Ardwick you will approach a roundabout with the O2 Apollo on your right hand side. At the roundabout, take the third exit onto Higher Ardwick and then the first left turn onto Ardwick Green North. St Thomas Centre is on your right hand side.

**From the A6 Southbound:** Go past Piccadilly train station, cross under the flyover, past the skate park on your left and take your third turning on the left (just before the park) onto Ardwick Green North. Follow the road around to the right and St Thomas Centre is on your left hand side.

### Parking

There is on-street parking around the St Thomas Centre, but this can get really busy. Therefore we have secured dedicated car parking space 0.3 miles / 5 minutes walk for visitors to the St Thomas Centre. The parking charge is £4.00 (all day).

The car park is monitored by ANPR cameras and the easiest way to pay is using the PaybyPhone app. You can also pay via the PaybyPhone website ([www.paybyphone.co.uk](http://www.paybyphone.co.uk)) or by calling 0330 400 7275 and following the instructions. Note that you will need a debit or credit card and the location number (809107) to pay.

### Walking Directions from the Car Park to St Thomas Centre

**(0.3 miles / 5 minutes)** Turn left onto Union Street and directly right onto Brydon Avenue. Turn first left onto Cotter Street and second right onto North Street. The rear entrance to St Thomas Centre is on the left at the end of the street.

### Electric Car Charging

The nearest electric charging points are at the local BP petrol station, 0.5 miles / about a 10 minute walk from St Thomas Centre.
