How to get to St Thomas Centre

On Foot

From Piccadilly Station (Fairfield Street Exit): (0.5 miles / 12 minutes)

Walk straight ahead and cross Fairfield St by the pedestrian crossing (ignoring the crossing to the right). Follow London Road (A6) under the railway bridge and continue past the Manchester Marriott Hotel Piccadilly. Cross under the flyover, past the Projekts MCR Skatepark on your left, then cross over the road and continue on the A6. Continue past Speedy Services and Spirit Studios until you arrive at Ardwick Green North. Turn left past Fabric Church and follow the road around to the right behind the park. The St Thomas Centre is the church building on the left set back from the street next to Use Space.

By Bicycle

From the A6 Northbound: Once you are in Ardwick you will approach a roundabout with the O2 Apollo on your right hand side. At the roundabout, take the third exit onto Higher Ardwick and then the first left turn onto Ardwick Green North. St Thomas Centre is on your right hand side.

From the A6 Southbound: Go past Piccadilly train station, pass under the flyover, past Projekts MCR Skatepark on your left and take the left turning just after Spirit Studios onto Ardwick Green North. Follow the road around to the right and St Thomas Centre is on your left hand side.

We have cycle racks available and can loan you a cycle lock. If you require a lock please ask at reception.

By Bus

There is a frequent bus service between London Road (A6) and Ardwick Green via bus nos. 192, 201, 202, 203, 205. The closest bus stop is Ardwick Green South (opposite Ardwick Green Park).

By Train

The closest train station is Piccadilly Station (0.5 miles away). You can either catch the bus, a taxi or walk from the station.

By Bus (approx. 5 minutes) – take the Fairfield St exit from the station (signed ‘local buses’). As you leave the station by the taxi stand the bus stop is immediately on your right on the same side of the road. Take either bus numbers 192, 201, 202, 203, 205 and ask for Ardwick Green.

By Taxi (approx. 2 minutes) – take the Fairfield St exit from the station, the taxi rank is in front of you as you exit.

On Foot (approx. 12 minutes) – As above.

How to get to St Thomas Centre

By Car

Our postcode is M12 6FZ but please note that if you enter our postcode into Google Maps you will get the wrong location. Instead please enter St Thomas Centre.

From the A6 Northbound: Once you are in Ardwick you will approach a roundabout with the O2 Apollo on your right hand side. At the roundabout, take the third exit onto Higher Ardwick and then the first left turn onto Ardwick Green North. St Thomas Centre is on your right hand side.

From the A6 Southbound: Go past Piccadilly train station, pass under the flyover, past Projekts MCR Skatepark on your left and take the left turning just after Spirit Studios onto Ardwick Green North. Follow the road around to the right and St Thomas Centre is on your left hand side.

Parking

There is free on-street parking around the St Thomas Centre, but this can get really busy on weekdays. Therefore, if you are visiting the Centre on a weekday we recommend you park at Powerleague Manchester Central which is a 5 minute walk from the St Thomas Centre.

The car park is monitored by ANPR cameras and payment is by card using the Evology Parking app (location number 809107). The cost is £4.25 per day.

Note: the app will only allow you to book parking until 4pm on weekdays however there is a 3 hour free parking period which follows 4pm meaning you can park until 7pm.

If you are visiting on a weekend we recommend utilising the free on-street car parking around the Centre.

Directly opposite the car park is Brydon Avenue, head down this street. At the end of Brydon Avenue, turn left onto Cotter Street and take the second right onto Nivin Street. The rear entrance to St Thomas Centre is on the left at the end of the street.

The nearest electric charging points are at a local Esso petrol station, 0.5 miles / about a 10 minute walk from St Thomas Centre.
